



- The TV-VIDEO Combi does not contain any components that can be repaired by the customer. To switch off the TV-VIDEO Combi completely you must switch it off with the power switch.
- Make sure that air can circulate freely through the ventilation slots on the TV-VIDEO Combi.
- Make sure that no objects or liquids enter the TV-VIDEO Combi. If liquid is spilt into it, disconnect the TV-VIDEO Combi immediately from the power supply and call the After-sales Service for advice.
- The TV-VIDEO Combi should not be used immediately after transportation from a cold to a hot area or vice versa, or in conditions of extreme humidity. After unpacking the TV-VIDEO Combi, it should be allowed to acclimatize for at least three hours before installation.
- These operating instructions have been printed on nonpolluting paper.

1. CONNECTING YOUR TV-VIDEO COMBI

Important for the United Kingdom

This apparatus is fitted with an approved moulded 13 Amp plug. To change a fuse in this type of plug proceed as follows:

1 Remove fuse cover and fuse.

- Fix new fuse which should be a BS1362 5A, A.S.T.A. or BSI approved type.
- **3** Refit the fuse cover.

If the fitted plug is not suitable for your socket outlets, it should be cut off and an appropriate plug fitted in its place.

If the mains plug contains a fuse, this should have a value of 5A. If a plug without a fuse is used, the fuse at the distribution board should not be greater than 5A.

Note: * The severed plug must be destroyed to avoid a possible shock hazard should it be inserted into a 13A socket elsewhere.


How to connect a plug:

The wires in the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code: BLUE - 'NEUTRAL' ('N') BROWN - 'LIVE' ('L')

- **4** The BLUE wire must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter 'N' or coloured BLACK.
- **5** The BROWN wire must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter 'L' or coloured RED.

Before replacing the plug cover, make certain that the cord grip is clamped over the sheath of the lead - not imply over the two wires.

Connecting the cables




Special installation functions

You can select one of the following installation functions in order to adapt your TV-VIDEO Combi to your own specific requirements.

Automatic TV channel search

Your TV-VIDEO Combi will search for all TV channels. If you want to start the automatic TV channel search again, then follow the instructions below.

- 1 Press the MENU button on the remote control. The main menu will appear.
- 2 Select the line 'Installation' with the P-▼ or ▲P+ button and confirm with the ∠+► button.
- 3 Select the line 'Autoinstall' with the P-▼ or ▲ P+ button.
- 4 Press the ∠+► button. The 'Automatic TV channel search' starts.



5 When the TV channel search is complete,

'Installation comp.' will appear on the screen.

How to search for a TV channel manually, you can read in the section 'Manual TV channel search'.

- If you have programmed a recording (TIMER), a wake-up timer or a sleep-timer, you can't select the function 'Autoinstall'.
- Automatic Channel Installation:

Some cable companies or broadcasters offer the possibility to install TV channels automatically with 'ACI'. Information about the installation offered and how to select it, will appear on the screen.

This set will recognize and install TV channels with 'ACI' automatically.

TV channels will be stored from programme number 1 onward.

If 'ACI' cannot identify a TV channel, you can search for it using the method as described in the section 'Manual TV Channel Search'.

Searching for new TV channels

- **1** Press <u>MENU</u>. The main menu will appear.
- 2 Select the line 'Installation' with the P-▼ or ▲P+ button and confirm with the ∠+► button.

Important notes for operation

- We suggest that, from now on, you switch off your TV-VIDEO Combi with the STANDBY ♂ button on the front of the set or on the remote control. When the set is in the standby mode, a small red lamp at the front of the set will be alight.
- You can switch on with the ▲▼P+/- or P-P button, the 0-9 buttons or by inserting a cassette.
- Attention: If you use the power switch ① on the side panel, you switch off the set **completely** from the mains power supply. No programmed recordings will then be made. The red lamp at the front of the set will not be alight. After some time, the date and clock settings will be lost.

We advice you to keep your TV-VIDEO Combi connected to the mains at all times to ensure that programmed recordings can be made and that the television works normally. The power consumption will be low.

- Attention: If you switch off the appliance with the power switch ①, make sure that you have removed the tape by pressing the 1/2 button.
- If you diconnect your TV-VIDEO Combi from the mains, TIMER and channel information will remain stored for about 1 year and clock information will remain stored for 30 minutes.

4. TV SET FUNCTIONS

Selecting a TV programme

Select the required TV channel (=programme number) with the $\boxed{\blacksquare \nabla P + / -}$ button or with the digit buttons $\boxed{0.9}$ on the remote control.

- If you don't know the programme number of the required TV channel:
 - Press the ▲▼P+/- button for more than 2 seconds. The TV channel list appears on the screen.
 - Select the required TV channel with the ▲▼P+/- button. After 1 second the TV-VIDEO Combi will switch to the selected programme number.

Picture settings

- 1 Press the MENU button. The main menu appears.
- 2 Select the line 'Picture' with the menu buttons
 P-▼ or ▲P+ and confirm with the menu button

Switch on 'Auto volume cont.', to activate the automatic volume control. This will minimise sudden changes in TV volume, e.g. when commercial spots are being transmitted or when switching TV channels.

How to read TELETEXT

- Press the TELETEXT button to switch the TXT decoder on and off. The TV-VIDEO Combi is now receiving the TXT of the TV channel currently selected.
- To store the current page as preferred page, press the OK button.

The next time you call up TELETEXT, you will automatically turn to this page.

☐ If you want to select an other page, type in the number of the page with the digit buttons [0-9]. With the colour buttons on your remote control you can directly select the page numbers shown at the bottom of the TV screen.

Extra TELETEXT functions

To use the extra TELETEXT functions, press the MENU button, when you are in TELETEXT.

- □ To enlarge the print, select the symbol '⊕' and confirm with the OK button.
- To switch off the TELETEXT decoder temporarily, select the symbol '⊠' and confirm with the OK button.
- To call up a TELETEXT sub-page:
 - Select the symbol '○' and confirm with the OK button.
 - 2 Enter the page number of the sub-page with the 0-9 -buttons (e.g.: 0123).
- To call up concealed information, select the symbol '' and confirm with the OK button.
- □ To stop the pages from being turned over, select the symbol '⊕' and confirm with the OK button.
- To show TELETEXT transparently, select the symbol 'a' and confirm with the OK button.

5. RADIO FUNCTIONS

To switch the radio on, press the <u>RADIO ON</u> button. You can switch between radio and TV mode with the <u>RADIO ON</u> button. You can switch the radio off with the <u>STANDBY</u> button.

- You can be waken up by the radio. Read the paragraph 'Switch on function (WAKE-UP TIMER)' in the chapter 'Additional functions'.
- You can not call up any menu function while the radio function is switched on.

Selecting a radio channel

Select the required radio channel with the $\boxed{A \nabla P + /-}$ button or with the digit buttons $\boxed{0.9}$ on the remote control. The programme number will appear in the display.

Searching a radio channel

You can search for radio channels that have not been stored, while you are listening to the radio.

- **1** Press the **FM SEARCH** button.
 - The TV-VIDEO Combi will search for the next radio channel. The corresponding frequency will appear in the display.
- **2** Repeat step **1** to search for the next radio channel.

Storing a radio channel

- 1 If you want to store a radio channel, switch to TV-mode with the RADIO ON button.
- **2** Press the MENU button. The main menu appears.
- 3 Select the line 'Installation' with the menu buttons P-▼ or ▲P+ and confirm with the menu button ∠+►.
- 4 Select the line 'Radio store' with the menu buttons
 P-▼ or ▲P+ and confirm with the menu button
 ↓+▶.
- 5 In line 'Programme number' select the programme number you want the radio channel to be stored on, using the ∠+▶ or
- 6 Press the OK button.
- **7** To end, press the <u>MENU</u> button.

Displaying the frequency

Press the OK button while you are listening to the radio. You will see the frequency of the radio channel you are listening to on the display.

6. PLAYBACK FUNCTIONS

Playing a cassette

- 1 Put a cassette into the cassette slot.
- 2 Press the PLAY► button.
- ☐ If you press the <u>STOP</u> button once, the TV-VIDEO Combi will switch to pause. To stop, press the <u>STOP</u> button again.
- □ To eject the cassette, press the ■/▲ button on the TV-VIDEO Combi or press the STOP■ button on the remote control several seconds.
 - Before transportation, make sure that no cassette is in the TV-VIDEO Combi.
 - If you insert an erase protected cassette, the TV-VIDEO Combi will automatically start playback.
 - Some hired cassettes may have poor picture or sound quality. This is not a fault in your machine. Please read 'Eliminating picture interference'.
 - Some functions will automatically switch off after a while (for example, pause, still picture, picture search). This helps to protect the cassette and avoids wasting power.

Playing an NTSC cassette

With this set you can play cassettes that have been recorded on another video recorder in the NTSC standard (for example, American cassettes).

Some special features (for example, still picture) are not possible while you are playing an NTSC cassette.

Tape position indication

- Press the OK button to display the current tape position.
- To change the type of tape position display, proceed as follows:
- **1** During playback, press the <u>MENU</u> button.
- 2 Select the line 'Tape' with the menu buttons P-▼ or
 ▲ P+ and confirm with the ∠+▶ button.
- 3 Select the line 'Tape counter' with the menu buttons P-▼ or ▲P+.

- With the menu buttons <a>Image or <a=Image or <a>Image or <a=Image
- **5** Confirm with the OK button.

<u>Searching for tape position with the picture</u> (picture search)

- While a cassette is playing, press the I (reverse) or
 ►► (forward) button once or several times.
- 2 To stop at a certain picture, press the PLAY► button.
 - During picture search, the picture quality may not be so good and there will be no sound.

Still picture

- Press the STILL►
 button. A still picture will appear on the screen.
- 2 Each time you press STILL► again, the picture will move on one step.

<u>Searching for tape position without the</u> <u>picture (wind and rewind)</u>

- **1** Stop the tape with the **STOP** button.
- **2** Press the **(reverse)** or **(forward)** button.
- **3** To stop at a certain picture, press the **STOP** button.

Instant View

With this function you can switch to picture search during wind and rewind.

- If you hold the If you hold the If you hold the If you will wind or rewind, you will switch to picture search.
- 2 When you release the button, the TV-VIDEO Combi will automatically switch back to rewind or wind.

<u>Automatic search for a tape position (index</u> <u>search)</u>

At the start of each recording, the TV-VIDEO Combi will write an index code on the tape.

- 1 Press the INDEX ► button. Press the ►> button to select the next code mark or the << button for the previous code mark.
- 2 When the TV-VIDEO Combi finds the code mark, it will automatically switch to play.

Picture interference

When the picture quality is poor when you play a cassette, please follow these instructions.

Tracking during playback

- 1 During playback, press the MENU button.
- 2 Select the line 'Tape' with the buttons P-▼ or
 ▲P+ and confirm with the ∠+> button.
- 3 Select the line '**Tracking**' with the buttons $P \cdot \mathbf{V}$ or $\mathbf{A} P_+$.
- 4 Hold the buttons ◀∠− or ∠+► until the playback quality is at its best.
- **5** Confirm with the OK button.
- **6** To end, press the <u>MENU</u> button. This setting will remain until you remove the cassette.

Tracking during still picture

If the still picture vibrates vertically, you can improve the still picture as follows:

- 1 During still picture, press the MENU button.
- 2 Select the line 'Tape' with the P-▼ button or ▲P+ and confirm with the ∠+> button.
- 3 Select the line 'Jitter' with the P-▼ or ▲P+ button.
- 4 Hold the ▲ → or → button until the picture quality is at its best.
- **5** Confirm with the OK button.

- 6 To end, press the MENU button.
 - Please note, however, that interference may still occur with poor quality cassettes.

Cleaning the video heads

If horizontal lines appear on the screen when you play a cassette, you should clean the video heads.

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- **1** During playback, press the MENU button.
- 2 Select the line '**Tape**' with the menu buttons P-▼ or
 ▲P+ and confirm with the ∠+► button.
- 3 Select the line 'Cleaning' with the menu buttons P = V or A P =.
- **4** Press the OK button. '**CLEANING**' appears on the screen.
- 5 Wait a few seconds, until the message disappears and then press the <u>MENU</u> button.

7. MANUAL RECORDING

Use 'Manual Recording' to make a spontaneous recording (for example, a programme currently being shown).

- □ If you want to start and stop a recording manually, read the section: 'Recording without automatic switch-off'.
- ☐ If you want to start a recording manually but have it stopped automatically, read the section: 'Recording with automatic switch-off'.

Recording without automatic switch-off

- 1 Insert a cassette.
- 2 Use the ▲▼P+/- button to select the programme number you want to record, for example, 'P01'.
 - Programme number 'E1' is provided for recording from external sources (via the EXT. 1) scart socket).
 - Programme number 'Av' is provided for recording from external sources (via the Audio/Video socket AUDIO at the front of the TV-VIDEO Combi).
- 3 To start recording, press the <u>RECORD/OTR●</u> button on the remote control or **●** on the TV-VIDEO Combi. When you are recording, the red recording light at the front panel of the TV-VIDEO Combi will be lit.
- 4 Stop recording with the STOP■ button.
 - ▶ If you want to switch off the screen while recording, press the STANDBY () button **once**.
 - To switch the screen back on again, press the **A**VP+/- button.
 - During a recording you can only watch the current programme.

Recording with automatic switch-off (OTR one-touch-recording)

- 1 Put a cassette in the machine.
- 2 Use the ▲▼P+/- button to select the programme number you want to record.
- **3** Press the <u>RECORD/OTR</u> button on the remote control. When you are recording, the red recording light at the front panel of the TV-VIDEO Combi will be lit.
- **4** Press the <u>RECORD/OTR</u> button again and again until the display on the TV-VIDEO Combi shows the desired end time or length of the recording.
 - To cancel this information, press the <u>CLEAR</u> button.
- **5** Confirm with the OK button.
- 6 To end, press the MENU button.

Protecting your recordings

So that you don't accidentally delete an important recording, remove the special tab on the narrow side of the cassette with a screwdriver or slide the special tab to the left. Later, if you no longer want to protect your recording, you can seal the gap again with sticky tape or slide the special tab to the right.

Auto-assembling

You can use the auto-assembling function to join individual recordings without any major picture disturbance between them.

- 1 While the cassette is playing, search for the correct position on the tape.
- 2 Stop the cassette by pressing the STOP■ button. 'Pause' will appear on the TV screen.
- 3 Now start recording as usual by pressing the RECORD/OTR button on the remote control.

Se	Selecting the recording speed (SP or LP)		
poss	can reduce the recording speed by half. This makes it sible to record, for example, eight-hours instead of -hours on an 'E240' (four-hour) cassette.

8. PROGRAMMED RECORDING (TIMER)

Use programmed recording to automatically start and stop a recording at a later date.

To make a programmed recording, your TV-VIDEO Combi needs to know:

* the date you want to make the recording;

* the programme number for the TV channel you want to record;

* the start and stop time of the recording;

* whether you want to use VPS or PDC;

* the recording speed (SP/LP).

The TV-VIDEO Combi stores all the information in a TIMER block. You can programme up to 6 TIMER blocks a month in advance.

<u>'VPS' (Video Programming System) and</u> <u>'PDC' (Programme Delivery Control)</u>

With 'VPS and PDC', the TV station controls the start time and the length of the recording. This means that the TV-VIDEO Combi switches itself on and off at the **right time** even if a TV programme you want to record begins earlier or finishes later than expected.

Usually the start time is the **same** as the VPS or PDC time. But if your TV guide gives a VPS or PDC time which is different to the programme's start time (for example, 20.15 and VPS 20.14), you must enter '20.14' as the start time.

If you want to programme a time that is different from the VPS or PDC time, you must switch off VPS or PDC.

Programming a recording (with 'VIDEO Plus+')

All the information required for a programming is contained in the PlusCode programming number.



- 1 Press the TIMER D button on the remote control.
- 2 Select the line 'VIDEOPlus' with the P-▼ or
 ▲P+ button and confirm with the ∠+> button.

3 Enter the entire PlusCode programming number (up to 9 digits) printed in your TV guide next to the start time of a TV programme.

For example, 5-234-89 or 5 234 89

Enter 523489 for the PlusCode programming number. If you make a mistake, you can clear your instructions with the <u>CLEAR</u> button.

- If VIDEO Plus+ does not recognise the TV channel, 'P??' will appear on the TV screen. Instead of 'P??', you can select the programme number you want with the number buttons 0-9.
- If 'Code error' appears on the TV screen, this means you entered an incorrect PlusCode number or the incorrect date. Correct your instructions or end with the TIMER D button.
- If 'Daily error' appears on the TV screen, the date was incorrectly entered.
- The TIMER lamp on the front of the set will light up when one or more of the TIMER blocks are occupied.
- When you are recording, the red recording light at the front of the TV-VIDEO Combi will be alight.
- If the end of the cassette is reached during a recording, the TV-VIDEO Combi will automatically eject the cassette.
- If you forgot to insert cassette, 'no cassette' will appear.
- If you have inserted a cassette with erase protection when you want to start a recording, the cassette will be ejected.

6 Press the OK button.





Under '⊥P' select the recording speed 'SP' or 'LP' with the P-▼ or ▲P+ button.

- 6 When all information is correct, confirm with the OK button.
- ☐ 'Press STANDBY to start recording' will appear in the display. If the programmed recording should start within the next few minutes, press [STANDBY⁽¹⁾]. If the programmed recording should start at a later point in time, press the [OK] button.

A programmed recording can only start when the TV-VIDEO Combi is switched to standby.



 - The programming information has been stored in a TIMER block.
- 8 Make sure that the cassette you have put in can be recorded on.

Programming a recording with TELETEXT

With this function programming a recording will be considerably easier. In TELETEXT you select the TV programme you want record. All the required information for recording will be transferred and stored in a TIMER block. You can find more information on TELETEXT in the chapter 'TV SET FUNCTIONS'.

- **1** Select the TV channel you want to record from.
- Press <u>TELETEXT</u> to activate TELETEXT. Your TV-VIDEO Combi will now show TELETEXT for the TV channel you have selected.
- 3 With the number buttons 0-9 select the TELETEXT programme guide page. This page can be stored as the preferred page (see paragraph 'How to read TELETEXT').
- Press <u>TIMERO</u>. 'PLEASE WAIT...' will briefly appear at the bottom of the screen. Next, a highlighted title line will appear.
 - If 'NO TIMER INFORMATION ON THIS PAGE' appears, TELETEXT programming cannot be used for the programme you have selected. In this case, you should programme the recording as described in the paragraph 'programming a recording'.
- A cursor (■) will appear at the first programme line. Use the P-▼ and ▲P+ buttons to move the cursor (■) to the TV programme you want to record.

- If you want to cancel this function, press TELETEXT .
- 6 Press OK. The timer menu will appear. The required programming information has been stored in a TIMER block. Please check the information.



- - Under 'REP.', use the P-▼ or ▲P+ button to select daily or weekly programming.
 'ONCE': Recording only once.
 'Mo-Fr': Recording from Monday to Friday.
 'Mo-su': Recording from Monday to Sunday.

- 'Press STANDBY to start recording' will appear in the display. If the programmed recording should start within the next few minutes, press [STANDBY ☉]. If the programmed recording should start at a later point in time, press the [OK] button.

> A programmed recording can only start when the TV-VIDEO Combi is switched to standby.

 - The programming information has been stored in a TIMER block.



Parental control

This function will prevent unauthorised use of your TV-VIDEO Combi. All button-functions will be locked.

- You can make programmed recordings while the parental control is on.
- 1 Press the MENU button. The main menu will appear.
- 2 Select the line 'setup' with the P-▼ or ▲P+ button and confirm with the ∠+> button.

You can programme your set to switch off after a predetermined period.

- 3 Determine the time left until switch off in 15 minutes intervals using the P-▼ or ▲P+ button.
 - When you set the time to '0' with the <u>CLEAR</u> button the sleep timer is switched off.

- You can always simply select the switch-off time with the <u>SLEEP</u> button on the remote control.

- You can also always switch the programmed WAKE-UP TIMER for the radio and the buzzer on/off with the ALARM ON button on the remote control.
- 7 Press the OK button.
- 8 To end, press the TIMER D button.
 - If 'Date corrected' appears on the screen, press the OK button and check the date of the programmed Timer in the second entry field.
 - When a wake-up Timer has been programmed and switched on, the corresponding light will light up in the display.
 - If you want to switch off the alarm when it is going off, press the <u>STANDBY</u> button. If you want the alarm to repeat after ten minutes, press any key on the remote control or the Combi, except the <u>STANDBY</u> button.

10. Before you call an engineer

If, contrary to expectation, you have any problems using this TV-VIDEO Combi, it may be caused by one of the reasons mentioned below. You can also call the **customer service centre**in your country.

You will find the phone number in the enclosed guarantee leaflet. Have the model number (MODEL NO) and the production number (PROD.NO) of your video recorder ready.

Your TV-VIDEO Combi does not respond to any button being pressed:

- There is no power supply: check the power supply
- A programmed recording is currently being made: to cancel the programmed recording. press [STANDBY ()] for several seconds.
- Parental control is on: switch the parental control off.
- Continuous playback is on: switch the continuous playback off.
- There is a technical problem: switch off with the ① power switch for 30 seconds, then switch it on again.

Cassette is jammed in the TV-VIDEO Combi:

• Don't use force. Switch off with the ① power switch for 30 seconds, then switch it on again.

Remote control does not work:

- Remote control not pointed toward the TV-VIDEO Combi: point it at the TV-VIDEO Combi.
- Batteries have run out: change the batteries.

No picture when you play a cassette:

There is no recording on the cassette: change the cassette.

Poor picture quality when you play a cassette:

The cassette badly worn or of poor quality: use new cassette.

- Tracking is not properly adjusted or the video heads are dirty: turn to chapter 'PLAYBACK' and read the section 'Cleaning the video heads'.
- Read the section 'Eliminating picture interference'.
- You are playing a cassette with a LongPlay recording on it: Excellent picture quality is only guarateed with recordings made in StandardPlay recording speed.

The TV-VIDEO Combi will not record:

- The TV channel you want to record is not stored or you selected the wrong programme number: check TV channels stored.
- You have loaded a cassette which cannot be recorded on: undo the erase protection on the cassette.

Programmed recording does not work:

- You have not set the TIMER properly: check the TIMER blocks.
- You have programmed the wrong time or date: check time and date.
- You have put in a cassette that cannot be recorded on: undo the erase protection on the cassette.
- The machine has not been switched to standby when recording starts: switch off the machine with the <u>STANDBY</u> රා button before the TIMER recording starts.
- 'PDC' or 'VPS' switched on but 'PDC/VPS time' wrong: enter PDC or VPS time exactly to the minute. Have the aerial checked.

'Smart Clock' setting does not work:

- You have stored a TV channel on programme number 'PO1' that does not transmit TELETEXT: On 'PO1' store a TV channel that transmits TELETEXT.
- Poor TELETEXT reception: On 'PO1' store a TV channel with good TELETEXT reception.
- You have not activated the Smart Clock function: Switch the function '**ON**'.

You hear a very short and soft noise coming from your TV-VIDEO Combi at 3:00 at night:

 'Smart Clock' is checking the time: Switch off the Smart Clock function.

TELETEXT does not start at page 100:

You have stored a different preferred page: Store page 100 as preferred page.

Technical terms used

Current tape position : The part of the tape currently being played.

External source : A device connected via a socket (for example, scart socket) which is transmitting audio/video signals to the TV-VIDEO Combi.

Index marking : A marking which is automatically made on the tape at the beginning of every recording. This marking (recording ID) can be searched for with the Index search function.

Scart cable : Also known as a Euro-AV cable. This standard cable is an easy method of connecting various TV, audio and video devices, such as a HIFI and Dolby Surround set, video recorder, DVD player, SAT receiver, decoder, computer and similar devices. Other signals in addition to audio and video signals can be transmitted on it.

TV system : There are various systems for transmitting television signals, for example, PAL, SECAM, PAL BG, SECAM DK, SECAM L/L, NTSC etc. The system used by your television depends on which country you are in.

TELETEXT : Also known as TXT, Fasttext, Videotext, FLOF etc. **OTR** : One touch recording. This function enables you to select the switch-off time in intervals of 15 minutes.
